




Welcome!

Myra Coveney, clarinet soloist

Myra Coveney is a local Nebraska musician who holds a fulfilling career as a performing artist, educator, music administrator, and music entrepreneur/businesswoman. Myra received her bachelor's degree in clarinet performance from the University of Nebraska at Omaha. She is pursuing a master's degree next fall. In her professional career, Myra has performed across the Midwest and Texas with globally renowned artists such as Kinan Azmeh, Ron Blake, John Hadfield, Sarah Brightman, and more. A few of her most recent performances include programs with the Flute New Music Consortium's New Music Festival and the Nebraska Crossroads Music Festival.



In addition to enjoying an active performance career, Myra fills several administrative roles in the Nebraska music industry. She is the Rehearsal Manager and Operations Assistant for the Omaha Area Youth Orchestras at UNO since the 2023-2024 season. Myra has also served on the production team for the 2024 Nebraska Crossroads Music Festival.

As a music educator, Myra teaches in her own studio of private students. Her students have a 100% acceptance rate to All-State ensembles for two consecutive years. She also regularly works as a clinician, leading workshops at several schools across Nebraska.



Music Director, Dr. Joshua Kearney

Joshua Kearney is Assistant Professor and Director of Bands at the University of Nebraska at Omaha. He teaches courses in music education and conducting, and directs the Symphonic Wind Ensemble and oversees all aspects of the UNO band program. In addition to his duties at UNO, Dr. Kearney serves as Music Director of the Nebraska Wind Symphony. Kearney began his career as a teacher in the public schools south of Nashville, Tennessee. Dr. Kearney has worked as an adjudicator and clinician for ensembles of all levels—maintaining an active guest conducting schedule locally and across the United States. Additionally, Kearney regularly shares his research and experiences through conference presentations and workshops

around the country and abroad.

Dr. Kearney earned his Doctor of Musical Arts in Conducting from Michigan State University where he studied with Kevin Sedatole and his Master of Music in Conducting from Columbus State University (GA) where he was a student of Jamie L. Nix. He also earned his Bachelor of Music in Music Education from Columbus State University. Kearney holds affiliations with the Nebraska State Bandmasters Association, Nebraska Music Educators Association, National Association for Music Education, College Music Society, and the College Band Directors National Association. Kearney has served on the Executive Board for the Nebraska State Bandmasters Association and currently serves as Chair of the Social Media Committee for the College Band Directors National Association.

Associate Director, Keith Davis

Keith is a native of Kansas City, Missouri, and has made Omaha his home since 1991. He received his Bachelor of Music in Composition (1988) and Master of Music in Horn Performance (1990) from the University of Missouri-Kansas City Conservatory of Music. Keith has composed music for many instrumental ensembles, but has written mainly for symphonic and concert bands. His commissioned works include "A Western Plains Overture", "Native Hunters", "Delicate Survivors of Life's Mighty Storms", and "Bastion of Freedom." He has also done special arrangements for the Wind Symphony, including several holiday selections for our guest vocalists.



Keith has been a playing member of the Nebraska Wind Symphony since 1992 and also serves as the NWS Music Librarian. He is also a playing member with Orchestra Omaha and the Omaha Symphonic Winds. Keith lives in Gretna with his wife, oboist Deanna Davis, and their cat and two dogs.



Gregory Williamson, Guest Conductor

Gregory Williamson is a music educator from the greater Omaha area. A graduate of the University of Nebraska at Omaha, he currently teaches at Logan View Jr./Sr. High School as the 7-12 Music Director. He is in his first year with the Nebraska Wind Symphony. When he is not teaching or playing music, he loves to cook, spend time with his close friends, family and pets, and exploring new hobbies.

He is an active member of NAfME, ASCAP, NMEA, and NSBA, and has served on the NSBA Board as Public Relations Chair and NMEA Board as the Director of Auditions and Ensemble Affairs.
